CONDITIONS OF SECURE DETENTION

There are two cameras in the booking room; guidelines are posted on the cell door. Minors always have constant officer supervision. If a minor is under the influence they are taken to Palm Drive Hospital.

Constant auditory access to staff: Yes.

Access to toilets and washing facilities: Yes. There are facilities in each cell.
